

LED lighting can bring warmth to your home

Although LED lighting has been available in the automobile industry for many years, their use in lighting homes is a relatively recent development.

“Because this is a new technology, only available in homes for about the last five years, a lot of people don’t understand much about it,” said Michael J. Dove of Kitchen Lights by Michael J. Dove. “That is not unusual, because most people are still used to the old conventional types of lighting although they use a lot of energy and don’t look as good. It took a long time for engineers to create a warm and inviting color for use in homes. Initially, LED lighting gave off an unappealing blue color. The new LED lighting look is modern and updated and provides a cozy and comfortable atmosphere in the home.”

The new technology developed for LED lighting use in homes requires much less energy than traditional lighting, and provides a considerable difference in the longevity of the lights.

“You’re looking at a difference of 35,000 hours in LED lighting versus 2,000 hours with traditional types of lighting options,” said Dove. “If you use the lights three hours a day, they will continue to light your home for up to 32 years, and provide a savings of 80 percent in energy use.”

This quality product not only saves energy, but the disc light looks attractive as well. Engineered to provide immediate illumination for more square footage than traditional cone-shaped canned lights, LED lighting brightens up an entire space eliminating shadows and the need to use a nearby lamp for reading and sewing.

“Most of our homes in Southern California are poorly lit,” explained Dove. “We rely on lamps and usually need to cozy up to a lamp in order to read comfortably in our home. With our LED recessed lights at Kitchen Lights by Michael J. Dove, all you have to do is hit a switch to instantly illuminate the entire area, enabling you to perform tasks more easily.”

Although LED lighting can be installed in any room, Kitchen Lights by Michael J. Dove primarily installs recessed lights in kitchens.

“We do a lot of installation of under cabinet lights in kitchens, as well as bathroom and hallway lights,” said Dove. “It’s important to make sure that all lights installed in the kitchen are up-to-date, qualified and code compliant. We can redo the lighting in an entire house if a homeowner desires, replacing any existing lighting or installing light in rooms that have no lighting at all.”
